

- We use lots of team, partner and peer tutoring as well as using key adults to ensure all children are learning effectively and at their level.






Homework Grid

Tips for a great year

Reading, reading, reading! Daily reading with your child and asking questions about the text ensures they are understanding, comprehending and making predictions.

Repetition, repetition, repetition! Practise multiplication facts until they can be recalled quickly and accurately AND read, read, read!

Incidental Learning! Children need to know skills learnt at school can be transferred into everyday life.
