Class routines

- Timetable is on the board.

- Red Buddy class time to think and reset



Year 6 - May 15 - 17














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Volunteer Opportunities

Each class has a parent rep for the year. If you are interested in this role please email me. The role description was sent out by Mr Male.




















Communication
