


## Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Enable collaboration through teacher release for planning and moderation.	<b>\$13 000</b>
Provide additional teacher aide time targeted to support higher achieving students.	<b>\$28 000</b>
Purchase access to IMPACT and STEM resources.	<b>\$26 000</b>
